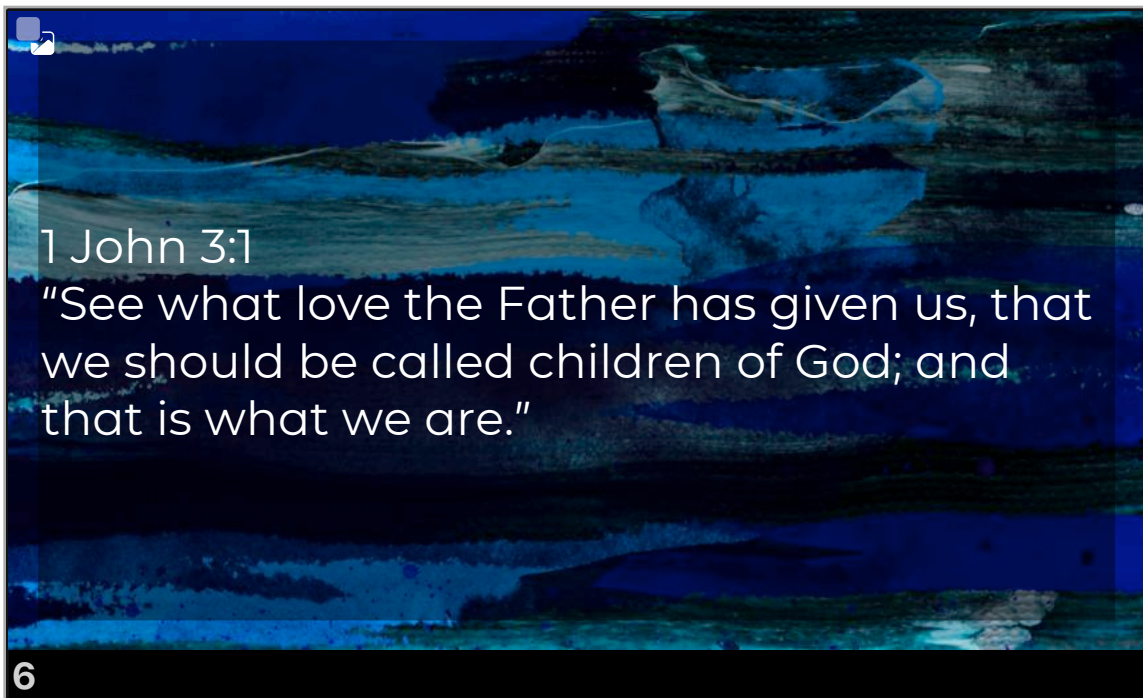
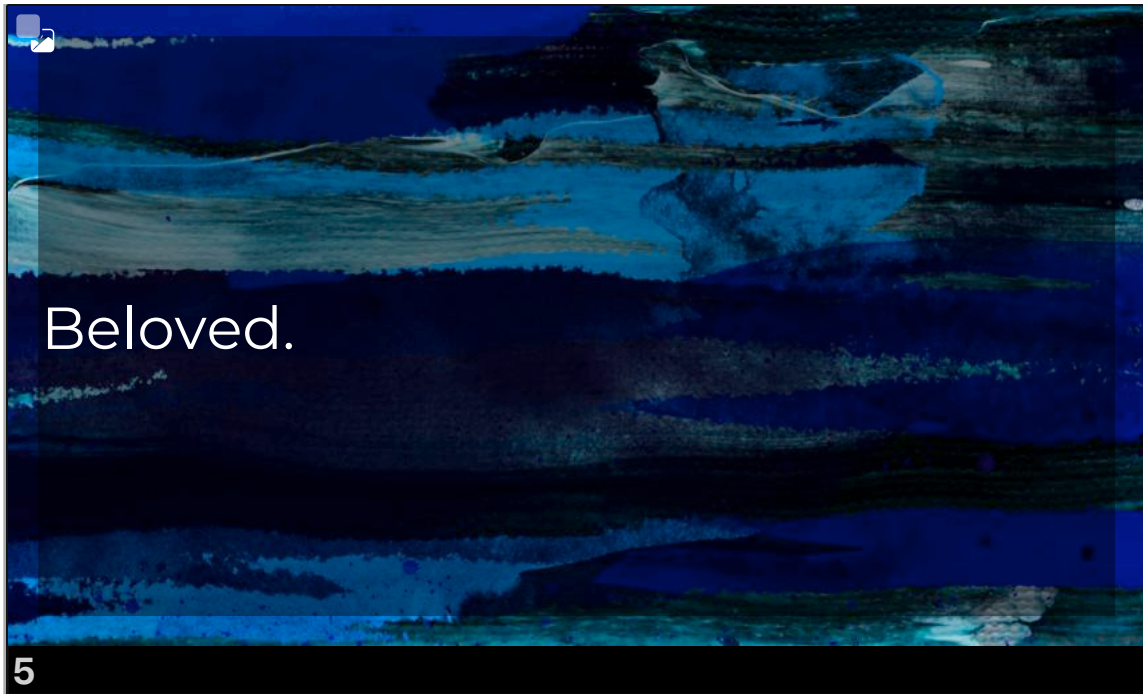
Colossians 3:12-17 *New Revised Standard Version*



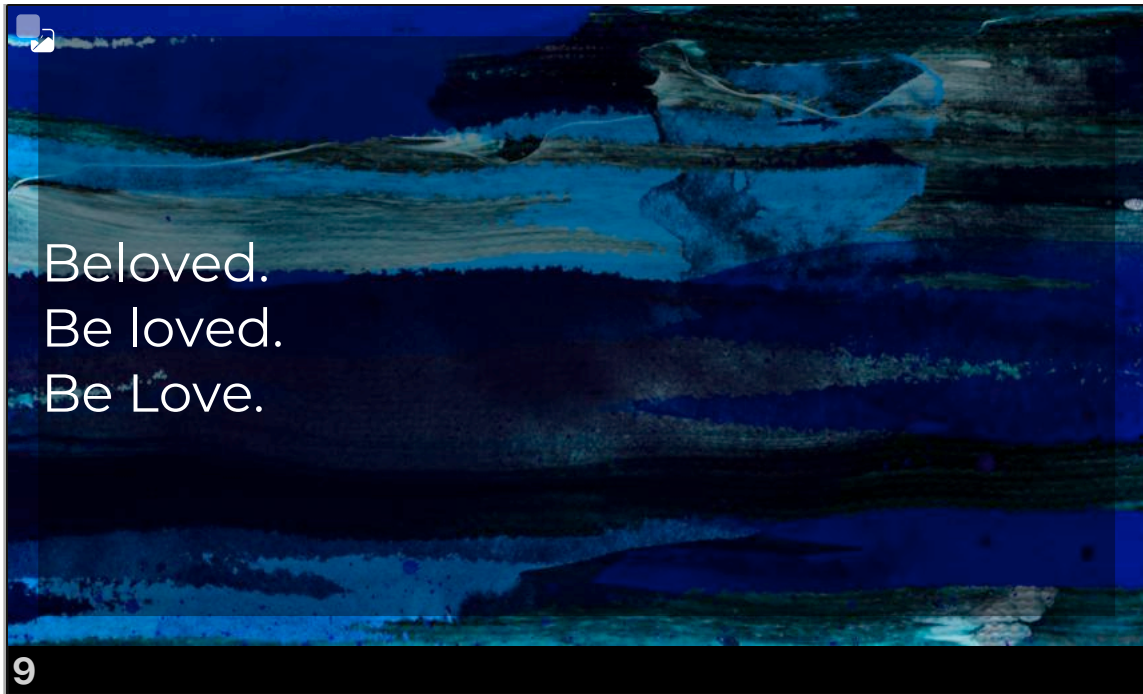

Romans 8:14-17

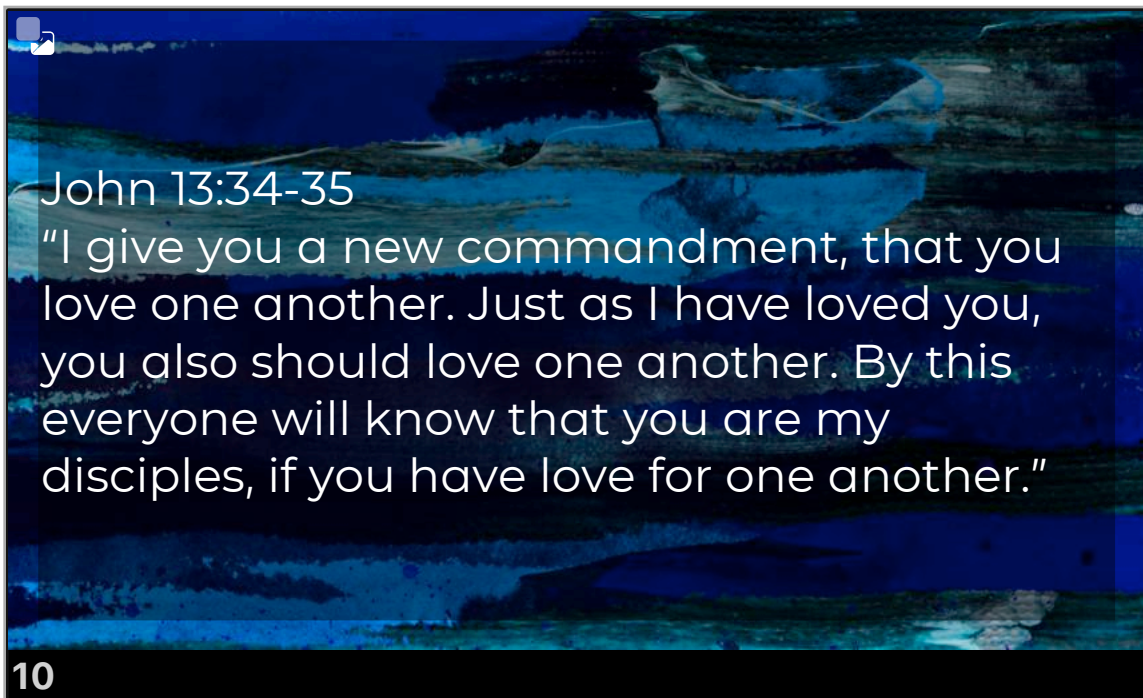
